I am a student at the University of Alaska. I am starting my 4th year next fall and will be graduating next spring with a double degree in Mathematics and Computer Plans for the future.

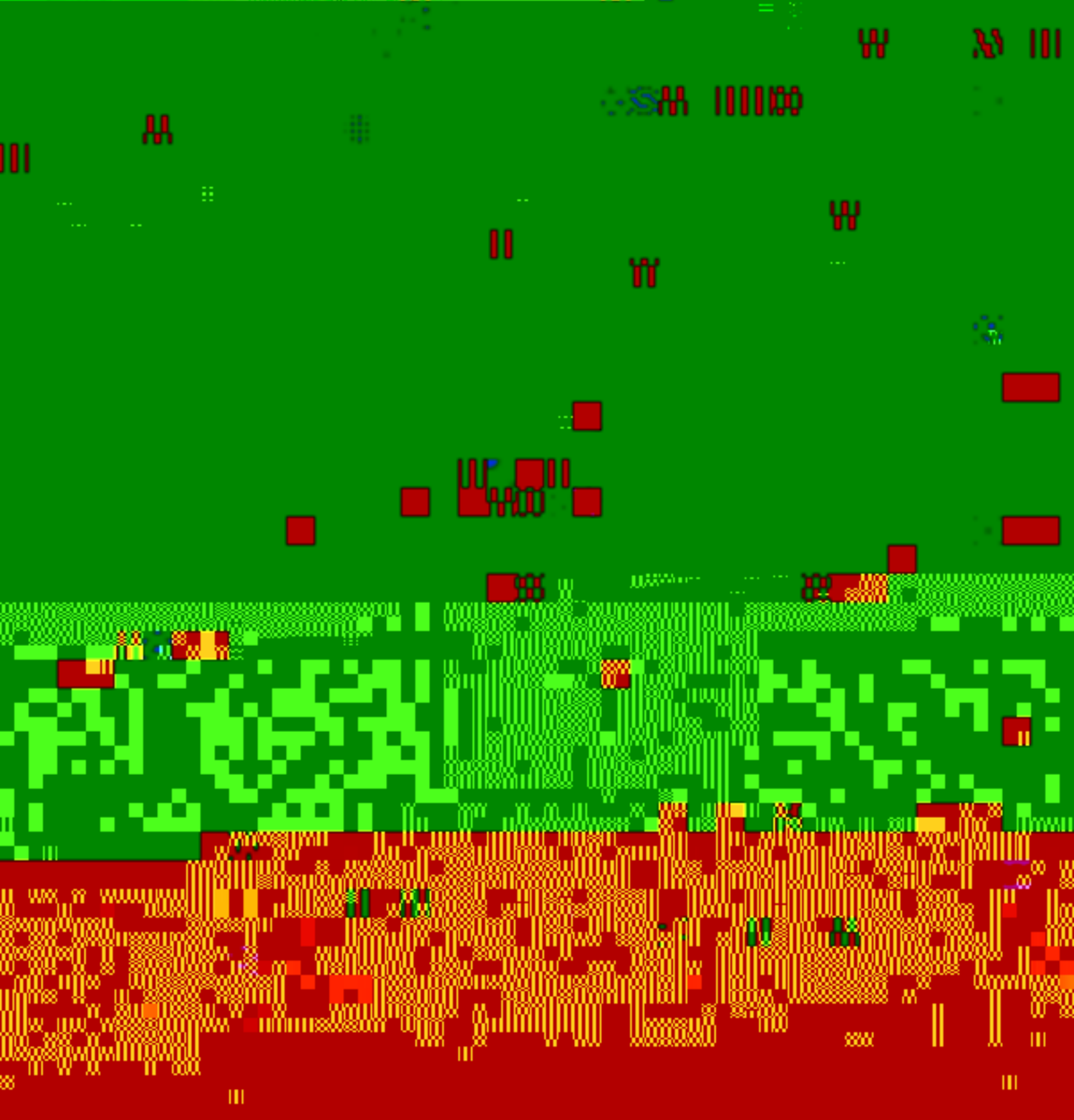

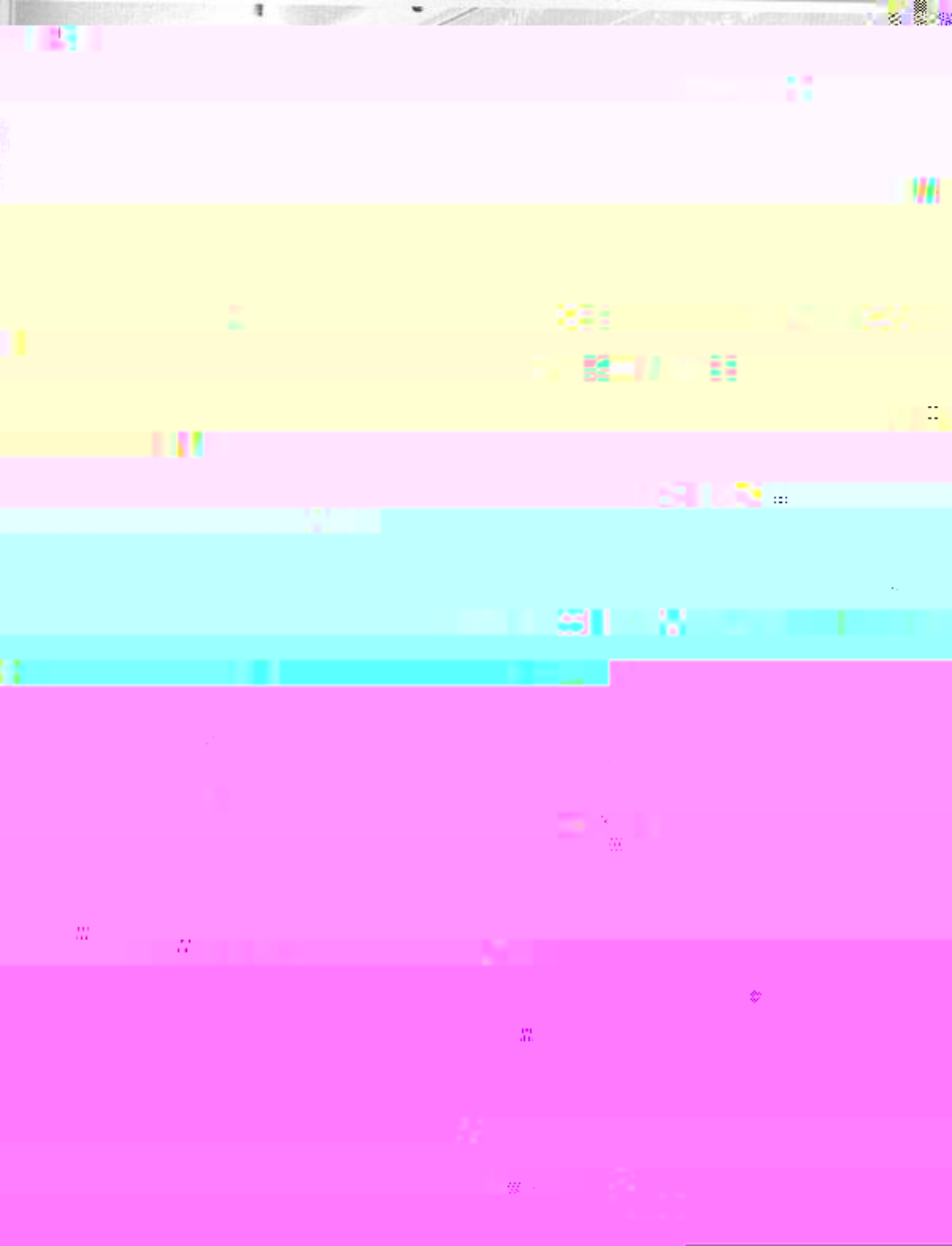

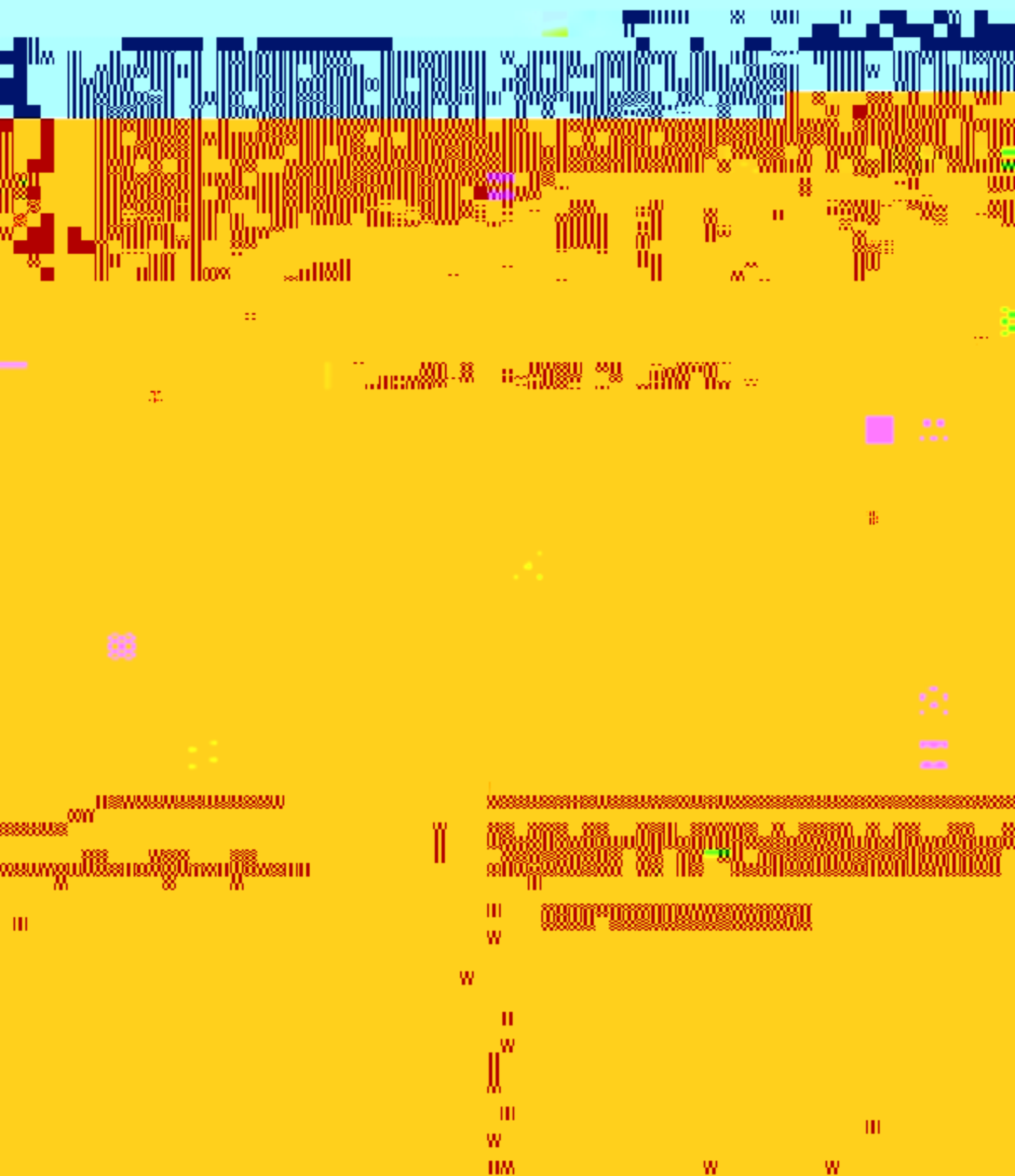
